I told everyone that I would include the pricing in our first issue of our newsletter. Here are our 2009 prices and fees:

Tent Sites: \$10.00 per day/site
RV Sites: \$15.00 per day/site or \$450.00 per month per site
Poolside Cabin Rentals: \$50.00 per day or \$750.00 per month
Daily Use Fee-Non Camper: \$5.00 per day/ per guest
Membership Fee: \$50.00 per year/ \$50.00 per year family(limit four people per family) * Membership Required*

*Vista's will be allowing monthly RV Site rentals to build decks off their RV's.

**Discounts for year round site rentals.

***Vista's does require monthly or yearly RV Sites to be maintained. All personal items must be stored in RV storage. No outside storing of items.

****Cabins sleep up to four people.

***** Limit one tent per site in the Tent Site area.

***** Pets on leash welcome. Pets must be attended at all times.
