who just come to see 'naked people.'" If you have come to stare and be rude then Vista's of Montana LLC. at Boulder Creek Resort is not the place for you! We appreciate your understanding, as we respect the privacy of our members.

Naturism is healthy both physically and mentally. Lewd behavior, and sexual behavior demonstrate disrespect of others in the resort. It undermines our image and will not be tolerated.

Please remember to be respectful. Nature has made 1000's of different body types. As Naturists and Nudist's, we strive for Body Acceptance and Body Freedom. We ask that you show respect to others, as you would want respect in return.

Please shower with soap before using pools or hot tub.

Prior consent for photography must be obtained from the Vista's of Montana LLC. at Boulder Creek Resort Management and from ALL individuals who are to be photographed or are possible background subjects in the photograph. Parents permission MUST be obtained before anyone under the age of 18 are photographed.

Drugs and Illegal Substances will not be tolerated. Period.

When sitting on a chair or bench please use a towel.

No Smoking with in an enclosed building. Outside is fine.

NO GLASS CONTAINERS in the pool or hot tub or creek areas or anyplace where accidental breakage can occur.

Clean up after yourself. Please leave area as clean or cleaner than you found it.

Discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated. Vista's of Montana LLC. at Boulder Creek Resort welcomes diversity including but not limited to: Singles, Couples, Lesbian, Gay, Bi, Transgender, Straight, Polyamory, Racial Heritage, Gender, Disability, or Familial Status.

Naturism from a Woman's Perspective

Imagine, being free to be yourself. Free to relax, Free to accept yourself just as you are, Free to accept others as they are. Free to experience who you are inside more than what you show outside. Free to just be!

Remember running naked through the house or going skinny dipping as a youngster? Remember how free and exhilarated you felt? There was a sense of comfort, a sense of total acceptance, a feeling of total freedom, and a innocent disregard of the fears and inhibitions that develop with adulthood. You can recapture those feelings of freedom and that sense of self esteem and acceptance again.

With the growing acceptance of social nudism and nude recreation, more and more women are discovering what it is like to experience the spiritually liberating effect of social nudism. To be accepted as a person without regard to size, shape, scars, age, physical condition, and fashion. To be able to enjoy the fresh feeling of a gentle breeze against their skin. To bathe in the comforting rays of the sun as it warms their entire body.

Today, single women and women in relationships are joining naturist organizations in record numbers. Women of all ages and walks of life are enjoying clothes-free recreation. Women who feel at home with their bodies and enjoy sharing the experience with others. Young children, adolescents, young adults, middle aged women, and grandmothers alike are experiencing outdoor social nudism together. Professional women are finding solace, relaxation, and in general, a stress free escape from the day to day pressures of their careers. Newcomers to nude recreation may have difficulty imagining how wonderful it feels. But once they take the plunge, they quickly discover it is a natural, life

enhancing experience. It is the most normal thing in the world. Besides, imagine just how light your suit case can be when you visit a nudist facility for a weekend, or a vacation.

By joining a Naturist Club in your area, women can enjoy social nudism in a family oriented, non-sexual environment. They can participate in relaxing recreation, in discussion groups and experience personal growth workshops in a safe, non-threatening environment with like minded people.

By contacting a club or organization in your area, you can speak with female members to learn about their point of view and experiences. Most will tell you that when you are accepting of others just as they are, you'll be more accepting of yourself.

I am a Single Male, can I join? **YES!**

Some clubs and groups tend to limit the number of single members, while others seem to have a more relaxed acceptance policy for singles. It is a problem for many singles to find a club or group that will let them become members, and even the national organizations have noticed. One of the national organization has recently begun to encourage their affiliated clubs to accept more singles. It may take several attempts to find the right group if you are single. If you approach a group and they say no, just respect their viewpoint and try somewhere else. There is usually a group somewhere in your area that will accept you as member as a single.

However, if the driving distance to their meeting place is more than you want to commit to, another option would be start a new group in your area. Then you could plan to have a more open policy on single memberships.

The Nudist/Naturist lifestyle is a great way to meet a lot of interesting people, both married and single.

Nudist Groups are Not Sex Clubs

- 1 Nudist groups **are NOT** a dating service.
.
- 2 Nudist groups **are NOT** a swingers club.
.
- 3 Nudist groups **do NOT** allow touching between members outside of that
which you would reasonably expect to see at a non-nude social gathering.
.

Most groups are non-sexual, family oriented organizations that do not discriminate based on age, race, sex, sexual or affection orientation, physical condition, or marital status. Some groups are Gay oriented and we have included their clubs in our listings. However, all nudist groups expect you to respect the

rights of others and to conduct yourself in a non-offensive manner. Since good behavior is paramount to everyone having a good time, most groups follow a code of ethics and behavior guidelines similar to these:

- 1 The use of drugs, narcotics and illegal substances is strictly prohibited at any sanctioned function. NO EXCEPTIONS! PERIOD!!
- 2 Excessive alcohol consumption and/or drunkenness will not be tolerated.
- 3 Abusive language, rude, or crude behavior, or advances of an unwelcome or unwanted nature is not acceptable.
- 4 Public affection and/or touching among members shall be set to the same standards as acceptable affectionate behavior in a fully clothed public forum.
- 5 Children's behavior and care is the responsibility of the parent.
- 6 While nudist publications and literature are usually acceptable, pornographic or sexually explicit material and literature should be viewed in the privacy of your own home.

Nudist groups want you to have a lot of fun in the nude, but they will not tolerate inappropriate behavior!

Protecting Your Freedom

There is a tendency by some people to condemn anything that they don't personally believe in. Often times people go out of their way to "mind someone else's business", forgetting that imposing their personal ideas of right and wrong on other people is not what the USA was founded on.

The people who want to eliminate nudism are usually judgmental, bigoted and angry, and frequently of a very conservative religious bent. They believe in freedom, as long as you agree with their viewpoint. Of course, they also profess that GOD is always on their side. Unless they have a direct line to GOD, I doubt that.

Nudists are usually fair-minded, friendly non-judgmental people who believe in live and let live. In all the years I have been visiting nudist events and facilities, I have found fellow nudists to be kind, considerate of others and always a positive influence. But nudists do have one fault, they often fail to watch their politicians and non-elected government employees who have a hidden agenda of eliminating your freedoms. It is important that each of us protect the freedom of the nudist viewpoints.

It is equally important that we support other groups who are also experiencing the elimination of their freedoms. I urge you to do your part and remember the horrors of the Nazis as written by Rev. Martin Niemoeller, a German Lutheran pastor. **"In Germany, the Nazis first came for the communists, and I didn't speak up because I wasn't a Communist. Then**

they came for the Jews, and I didn't speak up because I wasn't a Jew. The they came for the trade unionist, but I didn't speak up because I wasn't a trade unionist. Then they came for the Catholics, but I didn't speak up because I was a Protestant. Then they came for me, and by that time there was no one left to speak for me." Rev. Niemoeller was arrested by the Gestapo for opposing Hitler and sent to the Dachau death camp in 1938. He was freed by Allied forces in 1945.

Please support others who are in danger of losing their rights, so there is someone to help us retain ours.

Singled "Out" by the Naturist System

As a single, do you find it difficult, at best, to participate in regular naturist activities? Do you feel discriminated against because you do not have a partner or spouse? Are you frustrated by this? If you can answer yes to any or all of these questions, then you should read on because you are not alone.

The United States of America has been addressing the idea of discrimination for decades. As a modern society we have developed a greater awareness of discrimination based on gender, age, race, physical and emotional abilities, and sexual preference, among others. State and Federal laws prohibit discrimination for purposes of employment, financial lending, and renting or selling real estate, just to name a few specific areas. Yet, the naturist movement seems to think that it is ok to discriminate against single people, and more specifically, single men.

Thanks to The Naturists Society for carrying the torch against this very form of discrimination. In 1981, the Naturist Society concluded: "***We deplore any nudist or Naturist group, club, park or resort which absolutely forbids single males or gay males or couples to attend. Is that clearly enough said?***" Further, the Naturist Society created an Agreement for private entities desiring to participate in the Naturist Society Network to sign, stating that they rejected such arbitrary rules (discrimination based on abstract social categories).

They agreed "to welcome persons carrying The Naturists membership card. It is understood that the Club may exercise its normal policies governing gate admissions."

The Naturist Society faced a massive reluctance of ASA landed clubs to remove all barriers to singles joining. They therefore conceded that a "quota," clearly announced and fairly administered, for admitting a significant number of persons not joined in state-sanctioned heterosexual marriages, was acceptable to gain TNS recognition.

The TNS Agreement with landed clubs is the only general document in North America protecting rights of individuals to visit these clubs and to be treated fairly. It has as much 'enforcement' traction as the TNS can muster. They have dropped landed and un-landed clubs from being published in the Network that have defaulted on the Agreement.

With the work performed by The Naturist Society, more and more clubs

are accepting singles, especially single men. There are now Singles Special Interest Groups (SIG) which have organized singles clubs and singles auxiliaries within regular clubs. However, this practice is still not widely accepted, or for that fact, known about.

It is unfortunate, that all too often clubs get caught up in trying to balance the number of “boys” and “girls” in their organizations. If the proper attitude toward Naturism is driving the heart and soul of a club, the balance will naturally find its own level. It does not have to be forced. After all, Naturism is not about having one woman for one man. It is about human beings enjoying nature, au naturel. The International Naturist Federation summed it up in their definition of Naturism: ***“A way of life in harmony with nature, characterized by the practice of group nudism with the object to boost self-respect and the respect of others and for nature.”***

What to Expect on your First Visit?!?

It is normal to be a little anxious about your first visit to a nudist event. But there is nothing to fear, all you will find there is a lot of nice people who couldn't care less if you take off your clothes or what your body looks like.


Nudists/Naturists accept you for the person you are, not the body you have. You will find the groups friendly and open to new visitors.
