Please shower with soap before using pools or hot tub.

Pets on Leashes welcome. Pets must not be left unattended.

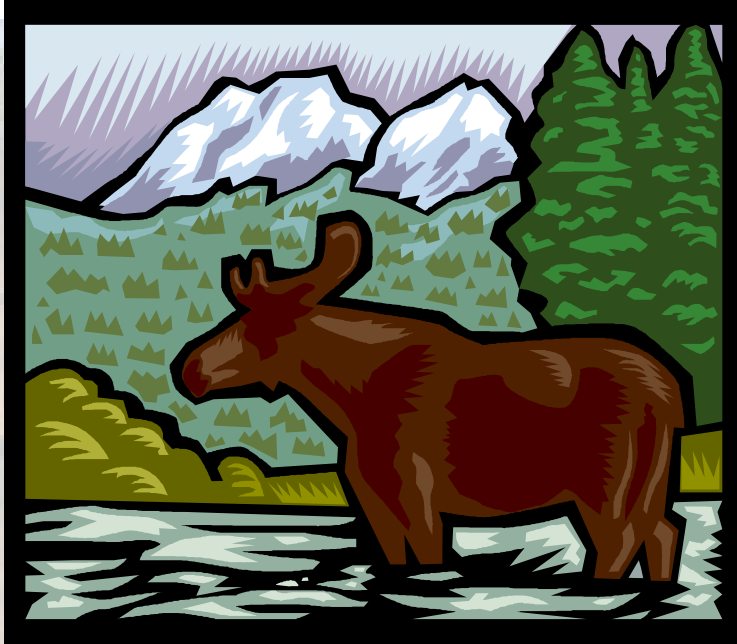
Monthly Rental RV, Cabin Sites are not permitted outside storage. Sites should be kept clean and tidy and belongings should be stored inside.

Being part of an Inter-racial gay couple for the last 17 years has taught me a few things. It's shown me that we need more diversity in Naturism for one. I am white and my partner is black. When we go to beaches or resorts, my partner is hesitant about being nude in front of other people. Why? He is usually the only person of color. He ends up feeling like the "token black man" in the group.

Many resorts have been in the past and still are today a very excluding group of people. If you don't believe me, then just visit any park in America. It is the same old song and dance, and that is why people of diverse backgrounds tend to shy away from resorts in America today. Granted, it is changing and a welcome change at that.

I would like to see resorts that clearly state in their Guidelines and Bylaws that people of diverse backgrounds are welcome. Such as, gay, straight, lesbian, bi, couples, transgender, singles, polyandrous, racial heritage, gender, disability, etc... Now wouldn't that be a nice change of pace.

As Naturists, we claim that Body Freedom and Body Acceptance are our guides. How can we claim this if we only see mirror images of ourselves? For Naturism to grow, we have to reach out to America's diverse populations. It is only then, that we can call ourselves true Naturists. Naturists must be inclusive, rather than exclusive. When I go to a resort; I want to see a rainbow of color in its members. When Naturism cuts out or excludes a segment

of society; we all lose. We lose all the gifts and knowledge of that segment of society. We lose sight of ourselves and each other.

When we join in Naturism as a group. Should it matter that the person sitting next to you happens to be black, gay, bi, polyamorous? No, it should matter if that person is a good human being. We can not find out if someone is a good person, if we exclude them simply because they happen to be different from ourselves. How boring the world would be, if we all were the same!

Embrace Diversity! It is then that Naturism will truly begin to blossom in our society.
